## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- Schools/Educators register teams (SEE ATTACHED LETTER).
- Each school must be represented by a manager.
- Any queries or appeals must be done by the manager.
- An appeal shall be submitted in writing to the CA or TD within 30 minutes after the completion of the specific round in question.
- Without the written appeal no dispute will be entertained.
- No parents or spectators are allowed in the PLAYING VENUE.
- All players must be dressed neatly in their school uniforms/attire.
- Players who have finished their games shall leave the playing hall, and not return before the next round.
- No equipment or furniture may be removed from the playing area.
- Players must make sure the results are recorded correctly.
- During all rounds, silence shall be strictly observed.
- Photographs of the teams/players may be taken during this event & will be published on social mediums.
- **No cell phones or electronic devices are allowed in the playing venue.**
- Failure to comply with this regulation shall result in a player immediately forfeiting that match.
- **Tuckshop will be available.**
- The players are not allowed to eat food or snacks during the games.
- One cool drink per player in a container with a sports cap will be allowed at the table.

## COVID REGULATIONS

**All players should take note of the following to comply with COVID-19 regulations under lockdown level 1**

- Only players will be allowed to enter the playing venue.
- No spectators or parents will be allowed inside the playing venue.
- Screening of all players, support staff, officials and attendees will be done upon entry at venue and recorded in a register.
- All players, support staff and attendees will complete a self-screening questionnaire to ensure efficient contact tracing where necessary.
- Any person displaying symptoms associated with Covid-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath or breathing difficulties) or people who are considered in a high-risk group should not attend.
- Players will not be allowed to leave the playing area, as well as its associated demarcated breakaway area during the day. Players should therefore bring their own food and drink.
- A tuckshop will be available.
- Sanitisation of chess pieces, sets and surfaces will be done in between rounds, but players must bring their own sanitation as well.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the entrance of the venue, as well as at strategic areas inside the venue and toilets. Toilets will have sufficient soap and roller towels as well as proper and well-marked Covid-19 disposal facilities.
- All players must wear masks covering both their noses and mouths at all times.
- All players must adhere to strict social distancing at all times.
- Players, support staff and officials over the age of 60, or people with comorbidities will be encouraged to be cautious and minimise exposure.
- No hands will be shaken at the commencement of the round, nor at the end of the match.
- Once the players are done with a match, and their results have been recorded, they become "Spectators" and must leave the playing area immediately and reside in the demarcated breakaway area.
- No informal games on private chess sets are allowed outside the playing venue in the demarcated breakaway area.
