Subject Choice- Grade 9 learners

Most Grade 9 learners do not possess the self-knowledge or necessary knowledge of the job market to make informed and relevant subject choices for Grade 10. This may result in some learners choosing subjects which may not prepare them for future career choices or which may limit their options in future. Subject choice counselling can assist learners to make an informed decision with the help of psychometric assessments.

The process of career counselling is a holistic one which takes into account the learner's current scholastic abilities, his academic, technical and clerical aptitude, his career orientation, his interests and narrative. When combining these aspects, a well-informed decision can be made. Since both subject choice counselling and choosing the correct subjects play a very important role in future success, we would like to offer you an opportunity to have your son assessed at Paul Roos Gymnasium. Please note that the assessment is <u>not compulsory</u> for any learner.

Process of Subject choice counselling of Grade 9's at PRG:

Psychometric <u>group</u> assessments of 5-6 hours will be done during school hours on **Tuesday, 12 March 2024 (for English learners)**, and will include the following:

- Aptitude Test (DAT-S, Advanced Academic Form)
- Interest Questionnaire (MB-10)
- Career orientation (Career Mentor)
- Narrative Questionnaire

Feedback:

A comprehensive report detailing the psychometric results, along with discussions of the results and recommendations for subject choices, will be prepared for each individual and emailed to you before the group feedback session for parents.

On Thursday, 18 April 2024, a feedback session will be held for both parents and students. The purpose of this session is to provide guidance on interpreting the report with understanding, thereby integrating the data into your decision-making process for informed choices. Before the session, the report will be emailed to you, enabling a more meaningful engagement as each part of the report is discussed.

Cost:

The cost per candidate for the subject choice counselling process which includes all the psychometric assessment, a group feedback session as well as a comprehensive report is R 950.00. Payment is due on or before the closing day of registration (5 March 2024).
